The USPS Network Distribution Center in Hazelwood is a 340,000 sq ft highly mechanized facility that processes over 150,000 packages daily. In one shift packages come in the door, process for correct location sortation and leave for next day or two day delivery in an area of about a 5-7 hour drive radius from St Louis. Robotic bins move on floor tracks, packages automatically scanned and placed in bins that then open and drop into correct delivery zone carts, tons of conveyors that look like an interstate system. This tour will show you what your typical package will go through in a future of increasing single package B2C shipping
