A.		Election of Officers: Awarded to chapters that have a current slate of officers, post offices on chapter website and send list of officers to RVP and VP of Chapters within 30 days of any changes after elections or to re-fill a position.	1,000	
B.		Chapter Leadership Roster: Awarded if Chapter Leadership Roster is sent to RVP by February 1 and August 1st of each year	2,000	
C.		Schedule of Meetings: Awarded if sent to RVP	1,000	
D.		Chapter by-laws reviewed (no more than 1x per year)	500

5.	FINANCE	POINTS	CALCULATION
A.	Chapter Operating Statements (see appendix) are a mandatory requirement for chapter consideration as Chapter of the Year. Statements are to be submitted through www.iopp.org twice yearly (July 31 for period January – June, and January 31 for period July - December). B.	Articles: Awarded for each article authored or co-authored by a chapter member that appears in a packaging publication. The chapter must provide the publication issue, page number and author, in order to receive credit.	250/ 5,000 max

A.	<u>Lecture:</u> Awarded for each chapter member who gives a packaging presentation in an educational or academic setting (i.e. career day, fund raising, etc.)	250/ 1,000 max.	
B.	Contributions to Packaging Education Basis: Receive 100 points for every \$1,000 donated for scholarships for packaging students or gifts to a packaging school.	100 per \$1,000 donation/ 500 points
